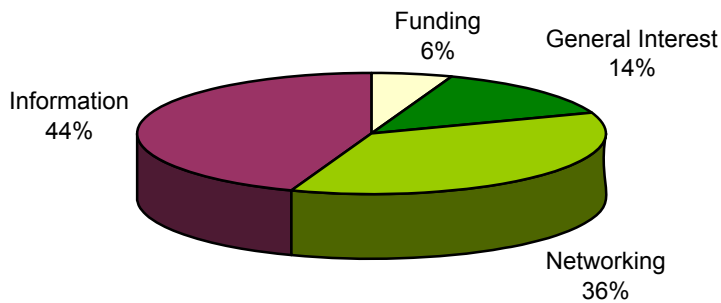
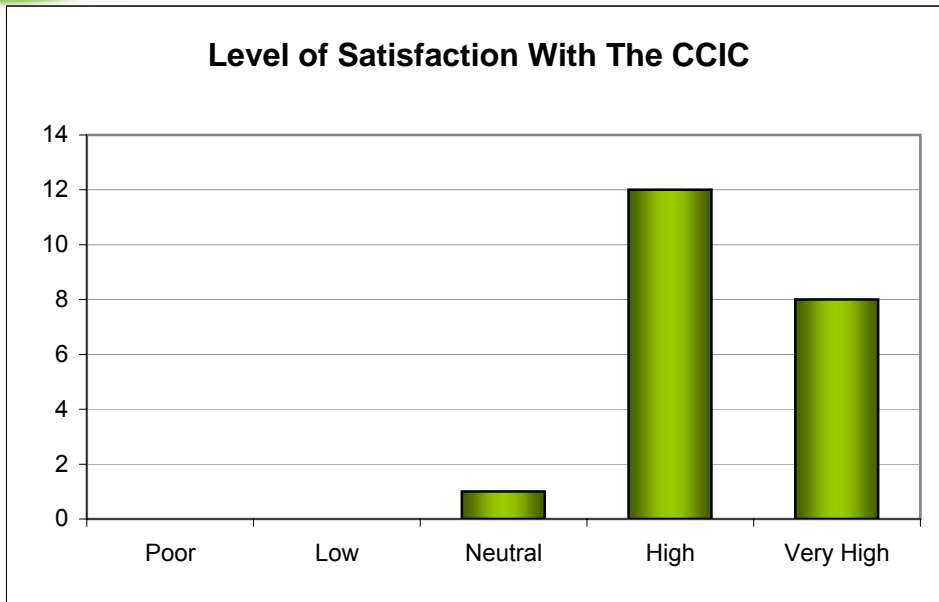

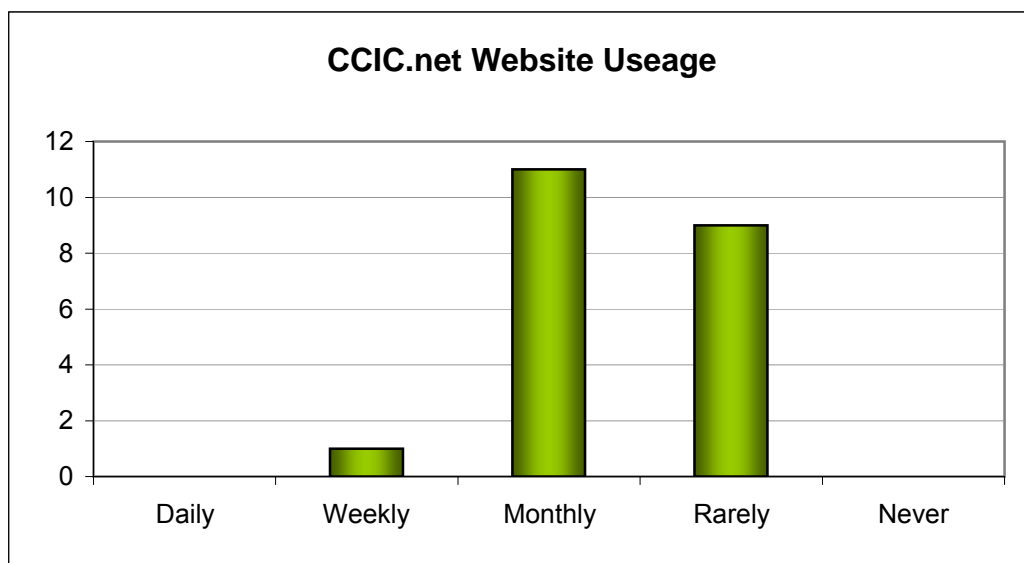
Suggestions on how to improve the organization:

- More online education like what Dr. Ware has done.

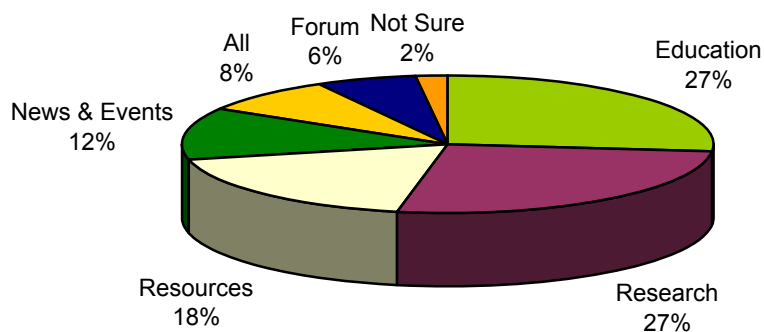

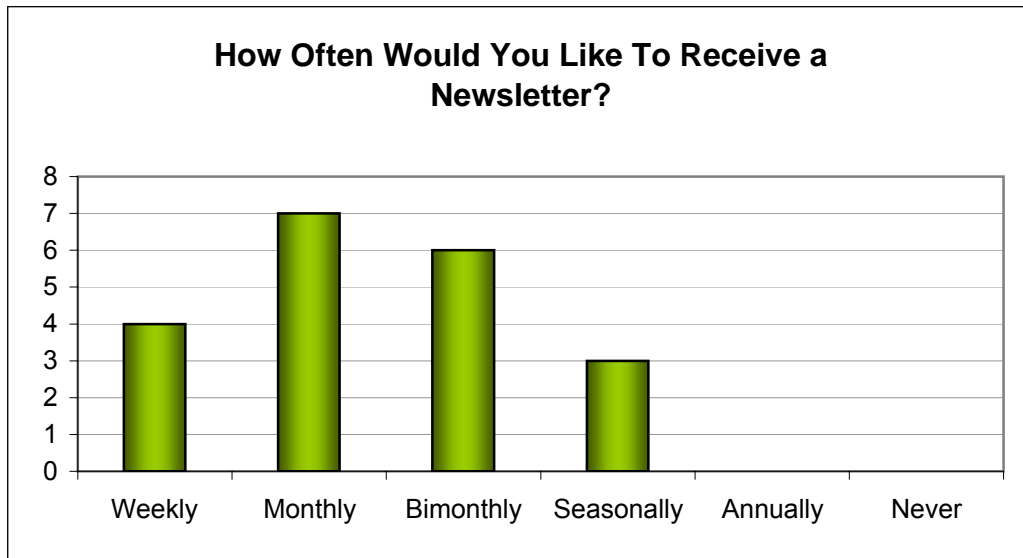
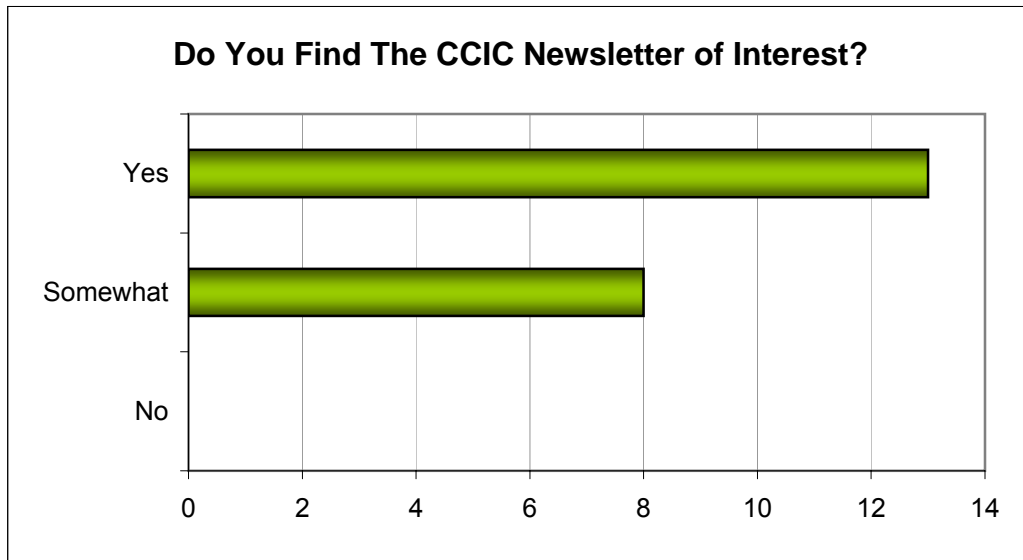


### Sections of CCIC.net you Accessed



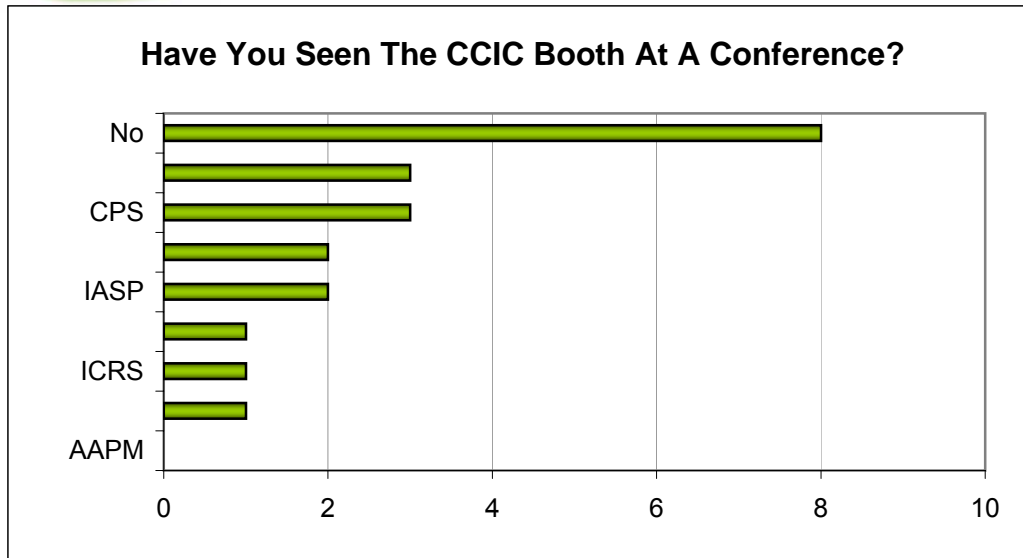
#### What would make the CCIC website more useful for you?
