



Graduate Student Summer Research Support

Amount: \$5000

Number of awards: 1

Application deadline: March 15, 2010

The aim of this program is to encourage and support basic science cannabinoid research. This award is intended to support a graduate student for their summer term 2010 in pursuing basic science cannabinoid research.

General eligibility criteria:

1. Applicants may only make one application per year per award.
2. Applicants must share in the vision, mission and purpose of the CCIC.
3. Members and Directors shall not be deemed ineligible due to their status as members or Directors to avail themselves of any program that may be offered or undertaken by the Consortium for the benefit of the general public, or any segment thereof, unless expressly excluded by a majority of the general membership (*CCIC Bylaw 5.11*).
4. Successful applicants will acknowledge support from the CCIC, should their research be published

Specific eligibility criteria:

Applicants must:

1. Be a member of the CCIC (defined by their membership status having been approved by the membership committee).
2. Have a supervisor who is a member of the CCIC (defined by their membership status having been approved by the membership committee).

The project must:

3. Be consistent with the CCIC's mission and purpose.
4. Be in compliance with the ethical rules in the institution associated with the research.
5. Be a basic science cannabinoid or cannabinoid related project.

Required documentation:

1. Application form – Fully completed, including; a description of the proposed research and a brief description of how the money requested will be used
2. Letter of support or reference from applicants supervisor
3. The candidates CV
