



Trainee Conference Support

Application deadline: March 15, 2010

The aim of this program is to support a graduate student or post-doctoral researcher for their presentation of an abstract at a national or international conference.

General eligibility criteria

1. A member may only make one application per year per CCIC award.
2. Applicants must share in the vision, mission and purpose of the CCIC.
3. Members and Directors shall not be deemed ineligible due to their status as members or Directors to avail themselves of any program that may be offered or undertaken by the Consortium for the benefit of the general public, or any segment thereof, unless expressly excluded by a majority of the general membership (*CCIC Bylaw 5.11*).
4. Successful applicants will recognize support from the CCIC by including the CCIC logo on their poster.

Specific eligibility criteria

Applicants must:

1. Be a member of the CCIC (defined by their membership status having been approved by the membership committee).
2. Be a registered trainee at a University at the time of application or a post-doctoral researcher or fellow.
3. Be engaged in cannabinoid or cannabinoid related basic science research.
4. Special consideration will be given to applications for attending cannabinoid focused meetings, including; Cannabinoids and Pain (Official Satellite Symposium of the 13th World Congress on Pain), International Cannabinoid Research Society Annual Meeting

Required documentation

1. Application form – fully completed.
2. A letter signed by the applicant and his/her supervisor confirming the relationship and that the applicant will present the abstract submitted.
3. A document confirming the acceptance of the abstract for presentation at a conference. If this is not available at the time of application, a document showing proof of submission is acceptable in lieu; however, proof of acceptance must be sent to the CCIC at least 60 days before the start of the conference.
